### Registration

The registration fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.*

### *Why have one camp do everything?*

Kids need and crave variety. That is why each week has a different theme and everyday has built in variety. We believe kids learn best and are most happy when they are not bored.

### *Tell me about your emphases*

**Academics** -- Science week is devoted to hands-on science experiments and "Around the World in 5 Days" focuses on history, geography, and cultures around the world. Daily we will have a short Spanish class and also work with the kids on their reading and math skills.

**Athletics** -- Besides spending 2 weeks on basketball and soccer camps, we will play daily in the gym and outside.

**Christian Values** -- All children and families are welcomed regardless of faith background, but please know that Bible stories will be taught and Christian values will be discussed.

**Ecology** -- The kids will plant and tend a garden big enough to make a farmer proud. We also highlight the value of recycling and practice it.

**Fine Arts** -- Kids love the 3 weeks focused on arts & crafts, drama, and music. Toward the end of camp the children will perform a children's musical utilizing props and backdrops that they make! We'll all have supper together that night and make it a family affair.

**Technology** -- The kids will learn how to take digital photographs and movies, edit them, and create cool presentations.

### *What are your rates and fees?*

Our registration fee is \$50 and weekly rate is \$100.

### *At \$100/wk, you cost much less than other day camps. Why?*

I'm glad you asked! First, we aren't trying to make a big profit from the day camp. Second, we want to do something great for the whole family. For parents, we understand the economy is tight and we would like to make this summer a little easier financially.
